Prayer focus: Nepal

We heard, last December, about Bishnu, an evangelist in Nepal. Over the recent period of lockdown, Bishnu's ministry was restricted to the capital, Kathmandu. He recently met a man called "Robert". Due to flooding, Robert was unable to reach the spring from which he normally drew water, and instead, by God's appointment, he visited Bishnu's training centre.

Sensing a gospel opportunity, Bishnu spoke to Robert after giving him water. Bishnu explains:

"I wondered if Robert was a believer.....he replied positively.....I asked if he knew the meaning of two words: mercy and grace. He couldn't answer. So I explained what these words should mean to a follower of Jesus.

"After that day he began to visit the centre every day to learn more.....One day, as I was teaching him from Romans 5 about justification, the Holy Spirit opened his eyes to understand the glorious gospel.

"Since then Robert is growing every day in the Lord.....Robert had intended to go to the Middle East for a job, but instead wants to give his life in service to the Lord. Please pray for our brother Robert!"

Please pray for Bishnu and Robert as they travel to share the gospel with people and villages in the north-west of Nepal.
